

TEMPORARY CLOSURE OF MIDDLEHILL ROAD & SMUGGLERS LANE COLEHILL

DORSET COUNTY COUNCIL has made an Order under Section 14 [1] of the Road Traffic Regulations Act 1984, as amended. All vehicles will be prohibited from proceeding along Middlehill Road and Smugglers Lane, Colehill from a point approximately 100 metres west of the junction with Merrifield eastward to the junction with Canford View Drive a total distance of approximately 2,000 metres. The order is needed in order to comply with Health and Safety Regulations, which require the provision of safe working areas and to minimise the likelihood of danger to Highway Users. It will come into operation on the 5 to 16 August 2013 a period of 10 days between 08.00hrs and 17.00hrs each week day. The road will be open over night and at weekends. But it will remain in force for 18 months and can be extended, with the approval of the Secretary of State for Transport, if necessary.

This Order will enable Dorset County Council to carryout carriageway surfacing works.

ALTERNATIVE ROUTE;

The alternative route, which will be sign posted, is as follows; from the eastern end of the closure at the junction of Middlehill Road near the junction with Canford View Drive proceed eastward to the Canford Bottom Roundabout. At the roundabout take the fifth exit off onto the B3073 Wimborne West Road. Continue westward along Wimborne Road West and Leigh Road to the mini roundabout near St Catherine's RC Church. At the roundabout take the second exit off and proceed northward along Lewens Lane and Rowlands Hill to the next mini roundabout by the Ambulance Station. At the roundabout take the first exit off and continue westward along Hanham Road to the next mini roundabout. At the roundabout take the second exit off and Priors Walk and them northward West Borough and Wimborne Road out of Wimborne to the junction with Burt's Hill. Turn right and continue northeast-ward along Burt's Hill and Long Lane to the junction with Smugglers Lane. Turn right and proceed eastward along Smugglers Lane to the western end of the closure at a point approximately 100 metres west of the junction with Merrifield. The reverse route applies.
