EDDC

Cllr Packer reported that Policy and Resources Committee had elected Cllr George Russell as the Council's Historic Environment Champion. The Committee had also agreed the Private Sector Housing Policy and the expenditure of £160,000 pa to cover the Disabled Facilities Grant. This sum was made up of 40% from EDDC and 60% from the Government; however this would be changing in the future with the Government contributing a lesser amount and the District picking up the deficit.

Cllr Wallace reported on the Appeal of the planning application at 72 Middlehill Road. The hearing on 1 April had concluded at 4.30 pm and the result was not yet known. The planning application at the old Colehill First School site had been granted and the planning application at land adjacent 5 Heath Close had not yet gone to Committee, although it was possible that it would be dealt with under delegated powers.

Cllr Gooch informed Members that EDDC was conducting a consultation on the Core Strategy, a document which would set out the broad development strategy for the Wimborne and Colehill areas over the next 20 years. A consultation leaflet had been made available for residents to comment on their preferred options.

The Chairman reminded Members that the Core Strategy could be viewed online and asked for their written comments to be sent to the Clerk in order that the Council could formulate a response.
