7. **Stick@30 Project**

Stick@30 is an initiative to remind motorists to keep to the speed limit. Wheelie bin stickers can be purchased and distributed to households so that, on bin collection days, the stickers will offer a visual reminder to motorists to monitor their speed and stick to 30mph. Cllr Johnson to report further on this initiative.

Members to decide whether they wish to introduce this scheme to Colehill. If Members are minded to agree to this initiative then a small working party should be set up to apply for funding from the Dorset Police and Crime Commissioner for the purchase of the stickers and also to liaise with other organisations such as PACT and Homewatch, to help with the distribution of the stickers to householders.

8. **Speedwatch**

PCSO Jess Allen wishes to encourage more volunteers to take part in the Colehill Speedwatch. It is considered that perhaps a daytime event could be held at Colehill Community Library to enable members of the public to see what Speedwatch is all about.

If Members are minded to agree to a daytime event then a small working party should be set up to liaise with PCSOs Allen and Evans to plan the event and arrange the publicity through social media and the Stour and Avon Magazine.

9. Bollards - Middlehill Road

Members will recall that DCC was replacing a wooden bollard at the chicane (Canford Bottom end of Middlehill Road) with a plastic post. Since reporting on this matter, DCC has decided to replace the other wooden bollard as well. DCC has advised that as and when wooden bollards are damaged in Middlehill Road they will be replaced with plastic posts. DCC's Community Highways Team Leader has said that DCC does not have the funds to replace all of the bollards at one time. When a bollard is hit by a vehicle DCC usually recharges the costs back to the driver of the vehicle.

A resident is concerned that the wooden bollards are not all being replaced at the same time (correspondence attached for reference) and has asked the Parish Council to support his concerns. To consider the Parish Council's response.

10. Middlehill Road

To discuss the concerns that residents and Members continue to have about this road in light of DCC Highways advising that there are no measures that can be taken other than by increasing visits from the Camera Safety team.

11. Burts Hill

DCC has provided the data on the recent radar monitoring at Burts Hill, as well as the collision data between 2014 and 2016. Copies of the collision data are attached, however the radar monitoring data cannot be printed. This has been emailed to Members and will be available at the meeting to view electronically.

The resident who highlighted the traffic speed concerns has been given the data and has been asked to provide a response in time for the meeting.

To consider whether there are any measures that the Council can ask DCC to introduce at Burts Hill.
