157.08 DECLARATIONS OF INTEREST

160.08 REMOVAL OF TREES AT TRIANGLE WOOD

It was decided to discount Banyards' quotation as it was considered too expensive and to discount BW King's quotation as it was considered the method of clear felling would damage nearby trees.
