#### 195.07 PARISH REPRESENTATION AT EDDC PLANNING COMMITTEES

Confirmation had been received from Cllr Gooch that he would represent the Council at the EDDC Planning Committee on 9 October to speak about the development at 72 Middlehill Road.

#### 196.07COLEHILL LANE

Dorset County Council proposed to close Colehill Lane between Colehill and Whitesheet Hill for maintenance work in summer 2008 and had asked this Council to decide when it would be inconvenient to commence the works.

After discussion it was RESOLVED that:

- (a) Dorset County Council be informed they should consult with local farmers and residents to determine the best time for these works to commence.
- (b) Dorset County Council be asked to plan the closure of the road so that it does not coincide with the closure of any other local roads, to avoid the problems experienced when Leigh Road and Uddens Road were both closed.

#### 197.07 <u>RIGHTS OF WAY</u> (Minute 148.07 refers)

The DCC Rights of Way Officer had agreed to attend the Highways and Plans Committee on 9 October to speak about the Public Rights of Way Extinguishment Provisions of the Countryside and Rights of Way Act 2000.

#### **198.07** <u>CLEANING OF STREET NAME SIGNS</u> (Minute 140.07 (d) refers) East Dorset District Council had informed the Clerk that there was no rota for cleaning street name signs; they are cleaned only when necessary.

#### **199.07 STREET LIGHTING** (Minute 105.07 refers)

Dorset County Council had advised parish councils to obtain third party insurance on the street lights they owned. A premium of £246.96 had been quoted from Zurich Municipal to insure the Council's 28 street lights for third party damage.

After discussion, it was RESOLVED that the Council would not insure the street lights for third party damage.

#### 200.07 PAVEMENT ALONGSIDE THE CO-OP CAR PARK

This item had been placed on the agenda at the request of Cllr Gooch. A resident had commented that drivers using the Co-op car park treated the pavement along side it as part of the car park. The resident said that visibility of pedestrians using the pavement was restricted by parked cars and with drivers using the pavement as an extension to the car park this made pedestrians vulnerable.

RESOLVED that Mr Andrew Berry, Management Engineer at Dorset County Council, be asked to emphasise the existence of this pavement as part of the proposed traffic calming measures in Middlehill Road.

#### 201.07 HIGHWAY MATTERS RAISED BY MEMBERS

- (a) Cllr Bartlett reported that the traffic islands at Canford Bottom roundabout needed to be cleared of weeds, litter and glass. The Clerk to contact DCC.
- (b) Cllr Davies was concerned that drivers would speed up when through the gateway at Smugglers Lane travelling towards Furzehill as this stretch of road is a 60mph zone. The Clerk to write to DCC requesting that the speed limit be reduced to 40mph.
- (c) Members mentioned that Burts Hill and the bottom part of North Leigh Lane which leads to Leigh Road, should also be reduced to 40mph, however it was decided that the Council should concentrate on persuading DCC to reduce the speed limit at Smugglers Lane first.
