### 254.14 HIGHWAY MATTERS FOR REPORT

- (a) Two pinch posts on Middlehill Road had been knocked down by a vehicle. DCC was aware.
- (b) Cllr Warren advised that there was a pick-up truck parked regularly on the pavement opposite the garage. He asked that the SNT be informed.
- (c) Repairs to the pavement at 1 Middlehill Road would be completed in due course.
- (d) DCC had advised of two road closures for Colehill Lane (for the fireworks event on 8 November and for the Remembrance Day parade on 9 November).
- (e) Road works by Southern Electric, SembCorp and Southern Gas would be conducted on Smugglers Lane to supply services to The Little House, Smugglers Lane.
- (f) DCC would be conducting a feasibility study on Middlehill Road to determine whether a pedestrian crossing would be possible. However, even if a pedestrian crossing was considered appropriate, DCC could not advise whether the budget would be available.
- (g) DCC could not extend the school zig zag lines outside 31 Cutlers Place as the lines were already the maximum 45.1m.
