95.05 <u>DECLARATION OF INTEREST</u>

96.05 CLLR SCOTT MILLER

The Chairman welcomed Cllr Scott Miller who was attending his first meeting as a Member of this Committee.

97.05 MINUTES

The Minutes of the Meeting held on 7 June, having been circulated, were taken as read, confirmed and signed.

98.05 INCOME AND EXPENDITURE ACCOUNTS YEAR END MARCH 2005

M. 101 (4) BYELAWS FOR COMMON LAND

The Byelaws would be erected on 15 August.

M 101 (5) KYRCHIL CORNER - CLEARANCE OF RUBBLE

A skip had been ordered for clearance of rubble on the conservation workday (23 July).

M 101 (6) THE TRIANGLE

The Tree Officer had no objection to removal of some Holly and young Sycamore.

RESOLVED that:-

102.05 THE TRIANGLE - RISK ASSESSMENT

Further to Minute 101.05.(6)(d), the Clerk had received a quotation from Scott Tree Services in the sum of £620 ex vat for tree work in Zones 1 & 3 listed in the Hazard Report. A second contractor who visited the site on 18 July reported that so many of the tree marker tags had been removed that it was impossible to quote for the work. The Clerk had inspected the site and found only 8 of the 70 tree tags still in place.

In all the circumstances it was RESOLVED that the quote submitted by Scott Tree Services be accepted and the work put in hand.

104.05 BT TELEPHONE KIOSKS - CONSULTATION 'RE-ALIGN PAYPHONE PROVISION TO MEET CONSUMER DEMAND'.

MINUTE 22.05.04

BT had advised of their proposal to re-align payphone provision in Colehill. The extended consultation period would end on 6 September. Payphones in Wimborne Road (opposite Beaucroft Road) and at the junction with Middlehill Road (Post Office crossroads) would be removed and, subject to agreement from OfCom, the kiosk in Sandy Lane would be made cashless.

Removal of the two payphones in Wimborne Road would mean no public

telephone facility was available between Wimborne Square and Middlehill Road. The kiosk at Post Office Crossroads, at the heart of Colehill and near the very busy crossroads, was essential for emergency use.

RESOLVED that this Council object to the proposed loss/reduction of service at these three locations.
