



Colehill Resilience – Shopping Guidance

General Guidance

The Government's [social distancing guidance](#) must be followed at all times:

- You should only leave your house for very limited purposes, including shopping for basic necessities, for example food and medicine, which must be as infrequent as possible.
- Minimise time spent outside of your house, and ensure you remain 2 metres (6 feet) apart from anyone outside of your household.
- Do not touch your face, and wash your hands as soon as you get home.

Local Shops

We are fortunate to have a range of local convenience stores within Colehill, all of which are well stocked and working hard to support us. Most residents live within easy walking distance of at least one of these shops, so please use them where you can for all your essential shopping, to reduce the number of car journeys being made.
