10. Colehill & Wimborne Youth & Community Centre

The Directors of the Reef Charity have asked that the Council, as sole member of the Charity, agree to a written resolution to approve New Articles of Association. These are based on the draft agreed by Council on 18th July, but replacing clauses 8 and 20 on trustee benefits and dissolution with standard wording requested by the Charity Commission. Members need to determine whether or not they agree to the New Articles of Association. If they agree then they need to resolve to appoint a representative to sign the written resolution on behalf of the Council, to signify the Council's agreement. (Note, it was resolved back in July 2023 that Cllr Nigel Bridle would sign this final version, without needing to come back to Council, but now that he is a trustee it is more appropriate for another Councillor to sign.)

11. Grant Aid

To resolve whether to grant a funding request of £1,170 to Life Education Wessex to fund their workshops in Colehill First School, Hayeswood and Dumpton.
