### 9. Christmas Tree

The final price is yet to be confirmed but thought to be in the region of £1250 plus £250 for delivery. Installation costs including a tree anchor, root barrier and watering system were agreed by full Council on 19<sup>th</sup> August. The Christmas tree has traditionally been paid for from the Chairman's fund.
