# 1. TREE MATTERS PERMISSIONS FOR TREE WORK

#### 2. REMEMBRANCE DAY

To note that arrangements are in place for the Colehill Lane and Wimborne Road closures. Letters have been sent to approximately 120 addresses in the area advising them of the road closures and road signs will be displayed the week before at either ends of Wimborne Road and at Northleigh Lane (junction with Beaucroft Lane and Leigh Lane) giving notice of the closures. Six volunteers have agreed to be marshals at the road closures.

#### 3. EXTENDED PAVEMENT – CRANBORNE ROAD

To note that the Clerk attended a site meeting at the Cranborne Road on 3 October with the DCC Community Highways Officer and the Secretary of the Furzehill Residents' Association to discuss extending the pavement from the Dogdean junction to the Wimborne Chase development. Emails have been sent to DCC and Bloor Homes to raise the matter and DCC has advised the Clerk to contact C&EDC Planning. The Clerk will update Members at the meeting if a response has been received.

#### 5. Deployment of the Speed Indicator Device in a 40mph Restriction

DCC has advised that they do allow the deployment of SIDs in 40mph restriction roads, subject to a health and safety check and confirmation that it meets DCC's agreed speed criteria.

DCC has confirmed that the Parish Council would have to pay for a speed test costing £250. Members need to note that the Parish Council has already advised DCC of the three areas where the Council will deploy its SID. If the Council decides to choose a fourth area then DCC will suggest that the Council purchases a second SID.

Members to decide whether to pay for a speed test at Wimborne Road West to find out if it meets DCC's agreed speed criteria.

## 6. Keep Clear Road Markings

To consider a request from a resident for "keep clear" road markings to be installed at The Acorns, off Wimborne Road West, (letter herewith on yellow paper) and to decide whether to ask DCC to implement it.

### 7. Traffic Calming as part of the Woodleaze Development

To note an email from the Head of Planning at Christchurch and East Dorset Councils explaining why it is unlikely that there will be a greater highways impact arising from the proposed development at Woodleaze (email herewith on blue paper).
