No objection
3/19/2437/RM	Land West of Cranborne Road Reserved matters details for 312 dwellings, public open space, vehicular, cycle and pedestrian access, connections to the SANG, landscape planting and surface water attenuation features. Comment – Colehill Parish Council are disappointed to see that all the higher-rise buildings are along the main road.
