42.19 Yellow Lines on Wimborne Road

There had been a number of surveys along the busy Wimborne Road, Colehill, and it was unlikely that Dorset Council would agree to more yellow lines. However, it would not be unreasonable to request broad yellow lines to be painted at the bus stop close to Nos. 83,85 & 87 Wimborne Road to give a better sight-line for intending passengers. These had been promised previously by DCC. It was clarified which bus stop was being discussed as some members were unsure.

RESOLVED that Dorset Council would be asked to paint broad bus stop lines as previously promised.

43.19 Traffic Survey

The crossroads at the Co-op was discussed along with traffic speed and levels in general. Cllr Urquhart suggested that a couple of Councillors should meet with the Police and Dorset Highways to discuss concerns, trying to take an overall view.

RESOLVED that the Extra Highways Services Working Party should hold a meeting with Dorset Council Highways and the Police.

44.19 Long Lane/Deans Grove

Discussing a resident's concerns about the wooden posts that have been erected along Long Lane, adjacent to The Warrens. Cllr Urquhart had spoken to the owner of the property who confirmed they belonged to him and he produced the Land Registry Filed Plan that showed the curtilage of his land extends to the road, including the section of land in question. The resident told Cllr Urquhart that Highways had been out to see him about the posts and they were not going to take any further action. However, it was RESOLVED that the Chairman would write to the owner to asked if he would consider replacing the posts with something more aesthetic.

45.19 Leigh Lane/Footpath from Park Homer Road

Members discussed the building materials seemingly being stored on the footpath at Leigh Lane/Park Homer Road. It was RESOLVED that the Chairman would write a letter to the resident outside whose property the materials were deposited asking for them to be moved.
